SPECIAL THANKS goes out to Jay and his son, A.J. Sturdevant for putting in the buoys at the entrance to the Cove lagoon.

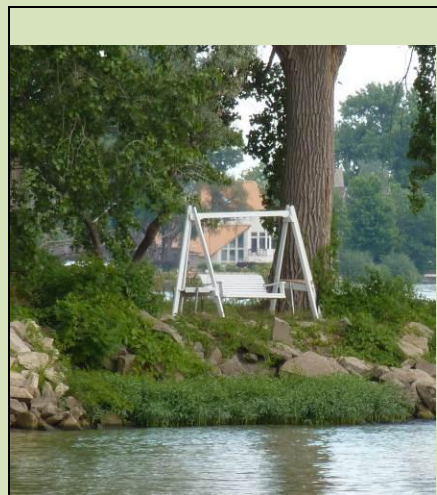
