--BEACH -

- No glass or motorized vehicles allowed on beach.
- Please remove doggie waste & deposit trash or recycle items appropriately. DO NOT place drift wood, fish or floating articles in the trash cans.
- Joel & Judy do a great job of cleaning the beach but be a good neighbor and help out when possible.

--ISLAND - Island storage is intended for seasonal boats & boat trailers only and must be clearly MARKED with owner's NAME. The Association is not liable for any damage to stored items. Please help to clear weeds around your stored item. The Board is looking into obtaining stones for entry driveway to alleviate muddy areas.

NOTE: The Island gate should be LOCKED when not in use - please help to maintain this security.

STREETS: Repair work on many holes and widening of Sunset cul-de-sac expected by early August.

High lake water level may cause some sewers to overflow to street - please clean up as needed. Beach buoys also closer to shore - use caution.
