Island Storage: - The Island has always been designated for storage of boats (<25 ft) and boat trailers. This year the rules were modified to allow utility trailers, as space allows (see Beach & Island Rules document on the website). **All items must be clearly MARKED with owner's NAME.** After December 1st, any unauthorized items will be removed.

-As space permits, preference is that boats on trailers be parked on the Bay side; trailers w/o boats should be parked on the canal side.

-Also, owners are asked to check storage items periodically and remove weeds from under/around their items - do not leave overgrowth for someone else when items are removed!

-The Association is not liable for any damage to stored items.
