BOARD UPDATES:

--BEACH -

- No glass or motorized vehicles allowed on beach.
- Please remove doggie waste & deposit trash or recycle items appropriately. DO NOT place drift wood, fish or floating articles in the trash cans.
- Due to high water, beach buoys are closer to shore - use caution.
- Joel & Judy do a great job of cleaning the beach but be a good neighbor and help out when possible.

--ISLAND - Island storage items must be clearly MARKED with owner's NAME. The Association is not liable for any damage to stored items.

Please clear weeds around your own stored item!

The Board had stones spread on the Island entry drive this year and is scheduling to have a couple old trees removed. A broken children's swing seat was replaced. And a picnic table may also be purchased for the Island.

The Island gate lock has recently been broken. The Board will be replacing with a new lock and new keys. Residents will be notified to obtain a new key when they are available from Erline.
